Kia Ora Neighbour,

Relocation of House to 30 McCullough Avenue, Mt Roskill

We wish to notify you as a nearby neighbour that we will be relocating a three bedroom house onto the site at 30 McCullough Avenue. Kāinga Ora have a house being built off-site and it is now ready for delivery. We did communicate previously that we had the house relocation booked in early-September however due to unforeseen circumstances we have moved this to a new date in October (please see below).

Our traffic management plan for this relocation work requires us to move the home overnight. On the night of the move, we request all vehicles to kindly remain off the street for the relocation to take place. Cones will be put up on the street the day before as part of the Traffic Management Plan.

We have scheduled this house relocation work to happen as follows:

- When: Wednesday 5th October (weather permitting)
- Time: Between 4am 11am (approx.)

A specialist house relocation truck will bring the house on to the site. Once the house is sited safely, no further work will be undertaken until standard construction hours. While every effort is made to minimise disruption, the nature of this work means that lights and noise are inevitable.
