Thank you for your email of 19 April 2020 to Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982:

“What current housing sites does Housing New Zealand Own or Operate in the Mangere Bridge Region and what sites are currently in the pipeline to have Housing New Zealand Own or Operate activities on?”

Kāinga Ora reports the number of properties it owns and manages by Auckland Local Board. As at 31 March 2020, Kāinga Ora owned or managed 4,562 properties in the Mangere-Otahuhu Local Board. This included properties leased from private owners, Community Group Housing, and transitional housing. You can also find information about the number of Kāinga Ora properties quarterly on our website at <https://kaingaora.govt.nz/publications/housing-statistics/>.

Kāinga Ora is building homes on two sites in Mangere Bridge, located in Tapuwae Way and Wallace Road. These will provide a total of eight new state houses for people on the Public Housing Register. These are scheduled to be completed this year, but completion dates may be affected by the COVID-19 lockdown period and current health and safety requirements for builders working on site.
