- Engage with stakeholders on and then confirm stakeholder engagement approach
- Review performance requirements for new build properties in light of Accessibility Policy
- Enable the collection of asset information about accessibility features within Kiwi Ora systems
- 1 July 2020 – start to record new builds that meet full universal design standards as a baseline measure
- Ongoing engagement with MOH and ACC to identify and implement any operational efficiencies in the process for modifications
- Confirm approach for accessibility as part of the retrofit programme

From 1 August 2020

- Hold Accessibility Symposium
- Review standardised designs for new build properties in light of confirmed new build performance standards, identify any gaps and develop a plan to address them
- Develop business case for consideration about the role Kiwi Ora should play in funding modifications for our public housing customers where other funding is not available.
- New measure in our key accountability documents to reflect the target of at least 15% of new builds meeting full universal design standards from 20/21/22
